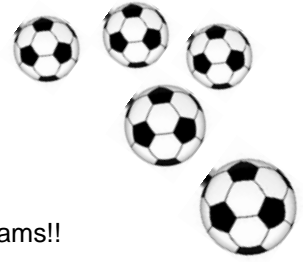

General Parents Circular No. 7 of 2010

Dear Parents,

Some information before we close for the 2nd term and all rush off to support our Soccer Teams!!

All children were issued with forms with regards to the NEW tuckshop system. Please ensure that you complete this and return it to your child's class teacher even if the reply is "no" at this stage.

- Tuesday, 8th of June - Children wanting to wear "civvies" must pay R5,00 to class teacher. Reports will be issued.
- Wednesday, 9th of June - School closes at 10:00. School uniform to be worn.
- Tuesday, 13th of July - School re-opens for the Third Term. Tuckshop is closed until the 16th of July for the issuing of tuckshop cards.
- Monday, 19th of July - Tuckshop re-opens.
Remember the card must have a credit for your child to be able to purchase food and an order form with the admission number has to be used to order tuck!



ENROLMENTS:

Enrolments for Grade R to Grade 7 for 2011 will be starting on Monday, the 19th of July.

The following items are required for GRADE R application / enrolment:

1. ONLY Most current Water and lights account / rental agreement in family surname
2. Original Birth Certificate / Passport of child
3. Identity Documents of both Parents OR Guardians

The following items are required for GRADE 1 – 7 application / enrolment:

1. ONLY Most current Water and lights account / rental agreement in family surname
2. Original Birth Certificate / Passport of child
3. Original Clinic Card / Immunization Card of child
4. Latest Report and any assessments which may have been done
5. Identity Documents of both Parents OR Guardians
6. Current or most recent Pay Slips or Proof of Employment of both Parents OR Guardians
7. 2 x recent I.D. photographs of the child (black, coloured or scanned)

No documents will be issued for you to complete unless ALL of the above items are supplied, (these must be original or clear certified copies).

The parent / guardian must complete the necessary forms.
Incomplete / dishonest information will make your enrolment nul and void.

You will be required to pay R1 500 if your application / enrolment is successful. ENROLMENT is entirely based on the area you are living in and if we have vacancies available at the time of application.

Enrolment documents can ONLY be completed at the school office, not faxed or sent home from 07:15 to 13:00.

Please ensure that you have all the basic family information to hand, i.e. work, doctors, two friends, telephone no's, postal and physical addresses, medical aid details.

We urge you to assist the school when you receive any newsletters / documentation which requires information to be completed and returned to school, ie. tear-off slips. Please complete and return such items to the class teacher as soon as possible. At the moment, this specifically pertains to Lady's Day and Tuckshop forms – complete these and return a.s.a.p., even if it is a nil return.

We have had one or two incidents of children begging for money from other children and parents. This is not permitted under any circumstances. Please ensure that you speak to your child with regards to this matter as this is unacceptable.
